



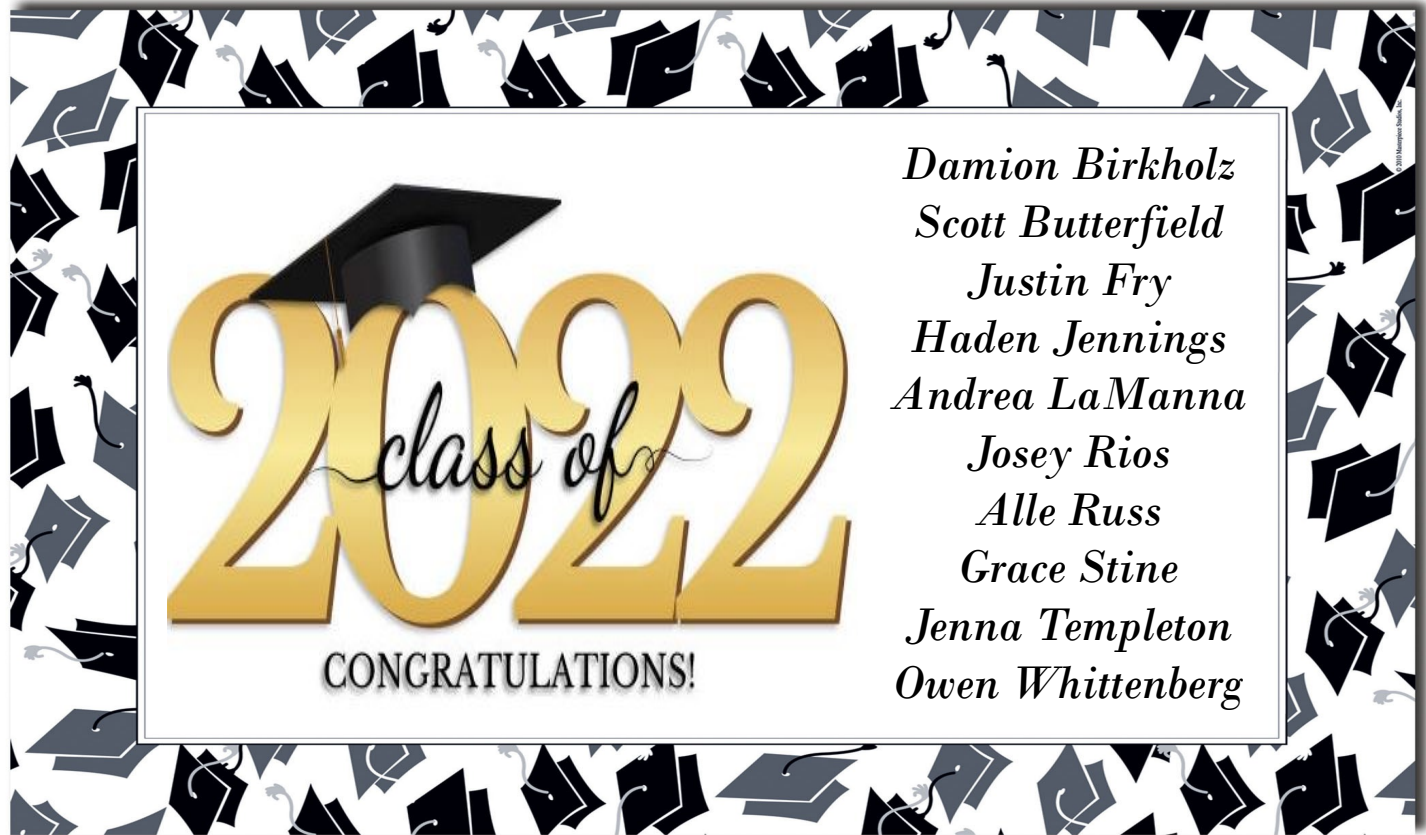

STORM WATCH FOR FIBER CUSTOMERS

During a power outage, the battery backup will provide the power needed to allow a customer's phone to continue to work for 8-24 hours, depending on battery purchased and call volume/length.

REMINDER: A CORDLESS PHONE WILL NOT WORK IN THE EVENT OF A POWER OUTAGE!

Once power is restored to the home, the battery will then automatically recharge. If the battery dies before the power is restored or you choose to opt out of a battery backup, you will be unable to make or receive calls until the power is restored. You can purchase an additional battery backup and your internet will stay active in the event of a power outage.

Stay Connected

The Lifeline and Affordable Connectivity Programs (ACP) are U.S. government programs that help many low-income households pay for broadband service. If you qualify for Lifeline, you receive a \$9.25 monthly discount on your bill and automatically qualify for the \$30 monthly ACP discount as well. The ACP has qualifications the Lifeline program does not, such as the free and reduced lunch program provided at **Lincoln Public Schools**. This program automatically qualifies parents or legal guardians of students enrolled at Lincoln School.

To find out if you qualify and to sign up, go to nv.fcc.gov.

Once you qualify, call us with your Application ID and we will get the discount applied to your bill.
