TURKEY SIZE	THAW IN REFRIGERATOR (SET TO 40 °F OR BELOW)	THAW IN COLD WATER (CHANGE WATER EVERY 30 MIN)
4 to 12 lbs.	1 to 3 days	2 to 6 hours
12 to 16 lbs.	3 to 4 days	6 to 8 hours
16 to 20 lbs.	4 to 5 days	8 to 10 hours
20 to 24 lbs.	5 to 6 days	10 to 12 hours

### USDA Nondiscrimination Statement
