The Upper Blackfoot Valley Historical Society was incorporated in 1992 with the first directors being Robert Didriksen, Ellen Mulcare, Annabelle Glenn, Benjamin Mayger, Myron Hatch, Jerry Burns, and Mary Spurlin. The Historical Society has a 4-acre museum on a site behind the Hi-Country Trading Post. It is believed that the site lies directly on the route taken by Meriwether Lewis in his travel through the Lincoln Valley.

### Notice to the Public:

LincTel provides voice and broadband telecommunications services throughout its service territory. LincTel is an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) and as such, receives support from the Federal Universal Service Fund.

For the exchanges 362 and 368, the following rates apply:

Single party residential service: \$18.45

Single party business service: \$22.75

Broadband services start at: \$69.90 if bundled with phone, \$89.90 for stand-alone.

*Note: Additional federal, state, and local taxes, fees and/or surcharges may apply such as subscriber line and 911 charges.*

LincTel voice service provides access to the public switched network, minutes of use for local service at no additional charge and access to emergency 911 services. Toll blocking at no charge is provided for low-income subscribers.
