STORM WATCH FOR FIBER CUSTOMERS

During a power outage, the battery backup will provide the power needed to allow a customer’s phone to continue to work for 8-24 hours, depending on battery purchased and call volume/length. **REMINDER: A CORDLESS PHONE WILL NOT WORK IN THE EVENT OF A POWER OUTAGE!** Once power is restored to the home, the battery will then automatically recharge. If the battery dies before the power is restored or you choose to opt out of a battery backup, you will be unable to make or receive calls until the power is restored. You can purchase an additional battery backup and your internet will stay active in the event of a power outage.
