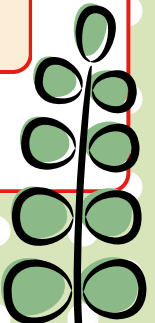
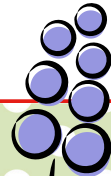
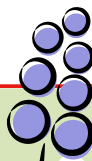
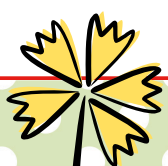
Do I Need a Surge Protector?

Households experience power surges on a daily basis whether it be caused from everyday household appliances kicking on/off or because of weather.

Over time, these power surges can damage electronic devices. Wireless routers and modems are some of the first things to be affected. Plugging your router and ONT into a surge protector will help protect them. Having your electronics and appliances plugged into surge protectors could save you an expensive replacement because of a little power surge.
